onoring Dr. Jan Redford today is especially appropriate as it brings historical focus back to the beginning vision of Gary Levering. She and an enthusiastic group of volunteer leaders embarked on a remarkable journey to bring support and hope to people experiencing depression or bipolar disorder. Jan had been working for many years as a

Psychologist at the University of Houston (UH) where every day she encountered students suffering from these debilitating illnesses. She found over the years that after her clients concluded treatment, they still needed mental health support at a cost they could afford. With the development of a Board of Directors and the forming of working committees, Gary's vision of support groups throughout Houston became a reality. Jan served as Chairman of the Board in 2010 and then served as Interim Director during 2011. She describes the experience of being part of the growth and success of re:MIND as exhilarating, rewarding and just great fun!

Jan's service to the Houston community has had far reaching impacts to countless people across many organizations. Jan served as President of the Junior League of Houston in 1980 and through this experience became aware of many areas of need in the community. In both her professional and community work, she has focused on the positive health and wellbeing of Houston youth. She received her Master of Social Work from UH and was employed





of Houston. She then received her doctorate in Counseling Psychology and began work as a Licensed Psychologist at UH. In a volunteer capacity, Jan served on the Board of Communities in Schools for most of its existence, having been one of the early founders of the group 40 plus years ago. She served as President of ChildBuilders, a child abuse prevention and parenting skills agency. She also served on the Advisory Board of Bridge-Up Menninger, focusing on the mental health of youth. She recently has served as a Trustee on the Powell Foundation Board of Directors, a foundation primarily dedicated to the education of at-risk children in our community.

Jan is particularly proud of initiating the partnership between re:MIND and Communities in Schools. She helped establish adolescent support groups within the Communities in Schools programs at many high schools where CIS is involved. Through this partnership, re:MIND has been able to help those students before their illnesses begin to seriously damage their lives.

Jan and her husband David feel lucky to have their extended family living in Houston. With four children, spouses, and 12 grandchildren, life is eventful and fun. She is very thankful to have been part of re:MIND's history and remains proud if its continued success.
